The club meets every other month on the first Thursday at 5:30 PM in the Dyer Library periodical room.

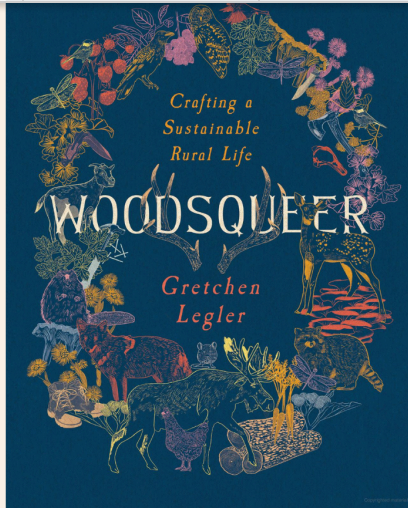

HEADER IMAGE: A moss is classified as a small nonvascular plant that reproduces with spores. They break down organic material and release nutrients. Mosses also help reduce the erosion of soil by absorbing water. Many species are called mosses that actually aren't. Club moss is a fern relative. Irish moss is actually a type of red alga. Reindeer moss is really a species of lichen.
